THE Public Leaders Ethics Secretariat has summoned Tanganyika district commissioner in Katavi, Onesmo Buswelu and the Cheyo councillor in Tabora Municipality, Yusuph Kitumbo, for alleged violations of public service ethics.

According to a statement issued yesterday by Commissioner of the secretariat Judge (rtd) Sivangilwa Mwangesi, the two leaders are expected to appear before the secretariat this Friday at a conference hall within Dodoma

regional commissioner's office to be questioned over alleged violation of code of ethics for public servants.

The advisory said that the matter will be heard openly and citizens who want to listen to the session will be allowed without any restrictions.

It said that one of the duties of the secretariat is to investigate behaviours and actions of any leader with the aim of ensuring that provisions of code of ethics for public servants are observed.

Recently, the secretariat said that there are some leaders who have avoided providing explanations on the sources of income they have and the value of assets they have on the asset declaration form.

It said that some leaders have failed to fill in the information of their spouses, especially financial information, while, others had received revarious rights without making a declaration.

The secretariat said the flaws give the impression some leaders still do no understanding about how to the declaration of assets a issues that need to be classification.
